<p><b>NEW COVER</b> Design a movie poster for a film adaption of the book. Write a description and choose who you would have play the characters.</p>	<p><b>READING</b> Write a list of unfamiliar words. Use strategies to read around the word to help you put it into context. If you are really stuck, use a dictionary.</p>	<p><b>SPELLING</b> Create anagrams of your words by jumbling the letters. Create clues to identify what word you have changed.</p>	<p><b>SPELLING</b> Write a mnemonic to help remember your spelling words/ pattern (Cold Ice Ruins Cozy Unicorn Sleeps= CIRCUS)</p>
<p><b>READING</b> Write or film a book review of the novel. Share your opinions on the plot, setting, characters and if you would change anything about it.</p>	<p><b>READING</b> Write or film a script re-enacting a part of the book.</p>	<p><b>SPELLING</b> Write your spelling words- write all consonants with one colour and vowels with another i.e. coastline</p>	<p><b>SPELLING</b> Write a poem or story using as many of your words as you can. Illustrate your poem.</p>
<p><b>READING</b> If the story was given a sequel book, what do you think it would be about and what would be the title? BONUS: Can you write a blurb for this new book or even try to write the first paragraph of this new story?</p>	<p><b>READING</b> Compare one of the characters in this books to a character from one of your favourite books. What is similar/ different about them?</p>	<p><b>SPELLING</b> Give each letter a number (e.g. a=1, b=2 etc.) and add up the value of the letters of your spelling words.</p>	<p><b>SPELLING</b> Create a word search using your spelling words for someone else to solve.</p>
